Stage 3 Drought Restrictions

We are still in Stage 3 of our Drought Restrictions. The level of the aquifer and the flow at the primary spring has to change from certain points as a running 30-day average before the particular restrictions can be changed or lifted. Currently, the level in the Edwards Aquifer shows that the conditions warrant using Stage 3 Drought Restrictions because the 10-day average is only at 640.2 and the San Marcos Spring Flow at 229. The average must stay above 640 in order for the restrictions to change from Stage 3 to Stage 2. We are asking for your cooperation in continuing to reduce your water usage.

Rate Increase for January 1, 2014

Effective January 1, 2014 your rates will be increased to the following:

Minimum charge \$34.00 (WILL NOT CHANGE)

0-5000 gal. \$4.10 per 1,000

5000-10000 gal. \$4.51 per 1,000

10000-20000 gal. \$5.39 per 1,000

20000-50000 gal. \$6.88 per 1,000

Over 50,000 gal. \$8.42 per 1,000

CCWSC continues to expend monies to develop and secure additional water sources for now and in the future. We have developed a well West of I-35 in the Trinity Aquifer in Comal County and have secured water rights in the Wilcox Aquifer in Eastern Guadalupe County near Gander Slough. The initial well and treatment facility for the Wilcox water will begin development in the coming year. These new rates and sources of water are needed to assure a safe, plentiful and continuous supply of water for our current customers as well as the newcomers moving to the area now and in the future.
